### **Course Introduction**

Beginner Camp: Start sailing from a young age and learn the ability to independently navigate and judge; To further learn the navigation of the Fast 28 keel boat, it requires a team of 4-6 people to operate together, cultivate teamwork spirit and courage to overcome difficulties. The core teaching content of the US Sailing Youth Sailing Certification course by the American Maritime Association has a complete advanced channel and authoritative certification system.



- Advanced Camp: With professional evaluation and personalized guidance, students can earn certification from CYA and US Sailing certificate by passing the qualification examination.
- Admission requirements for advanced camp:
- 1) Have participated in training courses such as sailing summer camps and possess basic sailing skills;
- 2) Holding a sailing skill certification certificate (including but not limited to RYA, CYA, USS, etc.).
- \*You can register for the advanced camp if you meet any of the above criteria.

### Sailing Coach: Xiaoluo Hong

Coach Hong is a senior sailor and captain of the Wanboofish Sailing Team. He is a US Sailing certified instructor and a Homesail Hobie sailing training officer, with more than eight years of youth training and teaching.



### Sailing Coach: Mengmeng Zhang

Coach Zhang, from Zhejiang Province, is CYA Senior Coach of the Small Sailboat Training System of China Sailing Association, a National Athlete, and a Retired Sailing Athlete. He represented Zhejiang Province in its triumph in the individual championship of the National Youth Championship, and represented the Bayi team in its victorious national championship season championship, and in two national championship runners up places. In 2015, he represented the Chinese team in the Spain 470 Princess Sofia Cup, the France 470 World Cup, and the New Zealand World Sailing Championships.

- During training, assistant coaches are assigned to provide additional support and guidance to ensure the safety of students. The coach student ratio is 1:6.
- Camp life coordinators are from Pao School and will provide students with enriching camp activities for an enjoyable and meaningful week away from home. The camp life teacher student ratio is 1:6.

# **Camp Life**



#### **Accommodation**

Students will stay at a seascape hotel in Wanboofish Sports Tourism Resort, a premier yacht club in Ningbo, with twin-share rooms, ensuite bathroom and 24-hour care service.

Students will stay on dedicated floors managed by our camp life teachers and nurse according to Pao School residential standards to ensure the wellbeing of all campers.







### Catering

Daily meals for students will be supplied by the resort's restaurant. Strict protocols are followed from procurement to processing at all levels to ensure freshness, hygiene and food safety, balanced nutrition between proteins and vegetables, as well as snacks and fruits.



### **Security & Medical Care**

The daily meeting will conduct a weather forecast and water risk assessment, and determine when to launch the boats. The coaches and safety boats will accompany and guide the students during the entire time on the water, and are supported by onshore medical staff.

Equipped with medical staff and dormitory security 24 hours a day. The camp will be equipped with emergency vehicle on standby and the district hospital is a 10 minute drive away.

- 1. In good health with no serious or infectious disease inhibiting outdoor sports.




- 2. Good command of English, be able to understand English instruction.
- 3. Have basic self-care ability and be willing to try and challenge outdoor sports.
- 4. NO special requirements for swimming skills. (Swimming is NOT a requirement for this sailing camp. During the programme, all campers will wear life jackets, our coaches will pay close attention to each camper's situation in real-time, and safety boats will be on constant patrol to ensure their safety.)
- Camp Address: Wanboofish Sports Tourism Resort, 999 Chunxiao Avenue, Beilun District, Ningbo, Zhejiang Province
- Cost: RMB18,500/person (incl. sailing course, coach, boats and rescue boat fees, Sailing test
  and certificate fees, insurance, Shanghai Ningbo round trip transport and within Ningbo City,
  catering, accommodation and other activities during the camp. The advanced class includes
  CYA exam fees and can be upgraded to dual certification by taking the US Sailing exam at
  one's own expense.)
