Ningbo’ with foreign coaches and Pao School teachers, the programme integrates the US Sailing Youth Certification Programme, offering a rich array of experiences including sailing training, evening activities, and a visit to the Oceanographic Institute. With Pao School’s renowned camp management, participants are guaranteed a safe, exciting, and memorable summer adventure.



Course Overview



Beginner Course:

The beginner course is centered around the US Sailing Youth Certification Program, where students will learn to sail the Fareast 28 keelboat. This requires teamwork from a crew of 4-6, fostering collaboration, problem-solving, and the courage to overcome challenges.

Certificate: US Sailing Certification



Advanced Course:

The advanced course offers personalized instruction based on each student's skill level, focusing on sailing the Optimist dinghy (OP). Students will develop independent sailing and decision-making skills, taking their sailing abilities to the next level.

Certificate: CYA Certification (students can optionally take the US Sailing exam to earn dual certification).

Advanced Course Eligibility:

To enroll in the advanced course, students must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 1, Have previously attended a sailing camp or training programme and possess basic sailing skills.
- 2, Hold a sailing certification (e.g., RYA, CYA, USS, or equivalent).
